## NATURAL RUBBER – INDIA

We obtain the natural latex which is used for the production of our condoms and which is certified by Fair Rubber e. V. from Tamil Nadu in South India.

The natural latex that is used for FAIR SQUARED condoms comes from the New Ambadi plantation in Tamil Nadu, South India. There, Fair Trade latex is produced in the most eco-friendly way, as sustainable as possible. Biodiversity is booming, the natural vegetation thrives and animals that were long gone have returned.

The plantation does not only offer its employees courses in sustainability – it also involves and shares knowledge with the other inhabitants of the village. Respect and awareness – not just in dealing with the environment – are a shared responsibility in the end.

Social responsibility and human coexistence are very important at the plantation. With the additional price for each kilo of latex, the standard of living of all plantation workers is constantly improved.

Together with the management they decide on the usage of the extra price paid for the latex. In the past, this bonus has already been used to partially cover medical costs, to support the payment of the costs of further education for the children and to pay a supplementary retirement insurance for the workers.

## WHAT DOES FAIR SQUARED MEAN?

FAIR SQUARED means exactly what it says. We are extra fair and stand for high quality products and sustainable production processes. FAIR SQUARED means that a surcharge is paid for ingredients that come from the poorest regions of the world. This additional price is used to improve the living and working conditions of small-scale farmers, plantation workers and their families. FAIR SQUARED stands for a fair treatment of all parties involved in the production process – for decent working conditions and for sustainable and eco-friendly economic activities. FAIR SQUARED does not support animal testing or child labor.

## FAIR RUBBER E. V.

Not all raw materials that FAIR SQUARED processes are covered by the Fairtrade Labelling Organizations International (FLO). For this, there are simply too many raw materials. One of these raw materials is natural rubber (liquid form: latex). It is obtained from the sap of the tropical tree “Hevea brasiliensis”.

The association Fair Rubber e. V. has set itself the goal of “contributing to the improvement of the working and living conditions of the primary producers of rubber by applying the principles of Fair Trade to the trade of rubber products”. This is what the association charter says – but what does it really mean?

Fair Rubber is good for the people. It is indeed the primary producers of natural rubber, i.e. the rubber workers, the plantation workers, and the small farmers, who should have the opportunity to participate in Fair Trade because the low prices make it impossible for them and their families to make both ends meet.

This is where Fair Rubber e. V. comes into action: the payment of a Fair Trade premium of 0,50 € per kg natural rubber ensures, to the largest possible extent, that production costs are covered even by low world market prices.

Thanks to the Fair Trade bonus, there is also a little scope for measures to improve their working and living conditions. How this premium is to be used is decided by FLO in the following ways: either through the board of the smallholder association or on plantations by a body consisting of selected staff representatives and delegates of the management.

All FAIR SQUARED products certified by Fair Rubber e. V. are condoms and upcoming products made of natural latex products.

## FAIR SQUARED CONDOMS

The natural rubber that FAIR SQUARED uses comes from Fair Trade. Our condoms are also certified by the Vegan Society, since we refrain from the usage of casein in our production. This protein found in cow's milk comes to use in the majority of condom production worldwide. FAIR SQUARED condoms are produced with great know-how and offer a natural and effective protection against unintended pregnancies and sexually transmitted diseases.



## FAIR SQUARED Original

Transparent, lubricated and cylindrically shaped condom, with teat end. Nominal width: 54 mm. Length: min. 190 mm. Thickness: 0.07-0.08 mm.

## FAIR SQUARED Ultra Thin

Ultra thin, transparent, lubricated and cylindrically shaped condom, with teat end. Nominal width: 53 mm. Length: min. 190 mm. Thickness: 0.05-0.06 mm.

## FAIR SQUARED Sensitive Dry

Dry, transparent, cylindrically shaped condom, with teat end. Nominal width: 52 mm. Length: 180 mm. Thickness: 0.06 mm.

## FAIR SQUARED XL 60

Extra large, transparent, cylindrically shaped condom, with teat end. Nominal width: 60 mm. Length: min. 215 mm. Thickness: 0.06 -0.07 mm.

## FAIR SQUARED Max Perform

Tight, transparent, cylindrically shaped condom, with teat end. Nominal width: 49 mm. Length: approx. 160 mm. Thickness: 0.07 mm.
